## **Congratulations to HKUST Swimming Team**

The 53<sup>rd</sup> Annual Aquatic Meet organized by the University Sports Federation of Hong Kong (USFHK) was successfully held on Sunday, 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2016 at Hong Kong Sports Institute. HKUST Swimming Team sent a team of 25 members including 15 males and 10 females to join this competition. The team brought home 1 gold and 1 silver medals this year. Our school was in the 7<sup>th</sup> position out of 13 tertiary institutes in overall.

Raymond Sumitra LUKMAN, Year 2 student from the School of Science won the gold medal in Men's 50m Freestyle and the silver medal in Men's 50m Butterfly. Raymond continued his legend in bringing the first gold medal of HKUST Sports Teams at the USFHK Competitions this year and also the second gold of HKUST Swimming Team in the USFHK Annual Aquatic Meet since the participation in 1991-92.
