

One GOLD & ONE BRONZE Congratulations to HKUST Swimming Team

The 54th Annual Aquatic Meet organized by the University Sports Federation of Hong Kong (USFHK) was successfully held on Sunday, 22nd October 2018 at Hong Kong Sports Institute. HKUST Swimming Team sent a team of 26 members including 14 males and 12 females to join this competition. The team brought home 1 gold and 1 bronze medals this year. HKUST was in the 7th position out of 13 tertiary institutions in overall.

Raymond Sumitra LUKMAN, Year 2 student from the School of Science won the gold medal in Men's 50m Freestyle and the bronze medal in Men's 50m Butterfly. Raymond continued his legend in bringing the first gold medal of HKUST Sports Teams at the USFHK Competitions this year and also the third gold of HKUST Swimming Team in the USFHK Annual Aquatic Meet since the participation in 1991-92.
