

The 20th HKUST Indoor Archery Open Competition

The 20th HKUST Indoor Archery Open Competition was successfully held on 24th February 2019 at the S.H. Ho Sports Hall. The competition first started in the academic year of 1998-1999. With the continuous effort of Archery Club committee members in the last two decades, the annual competition has now become one of the only two publicly recognized indoor archery open competitions in Hong Kong. This year, we have more than 100 top-level archers participated in three different divisions, Recurve - Student Division, Recurve - Open Division and Compound - Open Division.

In the Recurve – Student Division, the competition was intense, student archers coming from different universities took part in the individual and team events.
