

HKUST Student Athletes Represented Hong Kong in Archery Test Event for 18th Asian Games 2018

LEE Shuk Kwan (Edith), a year 3 student of Computer Science and Engineering, represented Hong Kong at the Archery Test Event for 18th Asian Games 2018 which is held in Jakarta, Indonesia in February 2018. There are nine national teams participated in this competition.

Shuk Kwan and her teammates performed well in Recurve Women's Team Event. They won Japan team with set point 6:0 in the first match and ranked third in the ranking round. They also knocked out the home team of Indonesia with set point 6:5 in the semifinal. In the Gold Medal Match, they lost to Mongolia with set point 2:6 and finally captured the silver medal in Recurve Women's Team Event.
