

On-Campus Water Sports Course (Oct 2020)

HLTH1010 students are invited to join the on-campus water sports course in Oct 2020. The **Basic Certificate Course in Windsurfing** is conducted in English by qualified instructors with lectures and practicum sessions. All equipment will be provided to course participants.

Students who have attended all sessions of the course and pass the practical test are eligible to apply for the Certificate and Logbook which are issued by Windsurfing Association of Hong Kong. The fees for Certificate and Logbook is HK\$ 30.

Pre-requisites:

1. HLTH1010 students who can swim at least 100 meters are eligible to join the water sports courses.
- Students are required to attend the Swimming Proficiency Assessment scheduled **at the beginning of the course** at the HKUST Outdoor Swimming Pool.
