

2017 USFHK Taekwondo Competition

The HKUST Men's and Women's Taekwondo Teams participated in the **2017 USFHK Taekwondo Competition** at Shaw Sports Complex, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University on 26th February 2017. This competition consisted of one-on-one Taekwondo sparring matches strictly followed the World Taekwondo Federation Sparring Rules. Only student-athletes who are black belt holders are qualified to compete in the competition.

There are more than 150 top student-athletes from different universities in Hong Kong joined this event, showing how vigorous and competitive the matches had been. Participants were divided into various weight divisions ranging from Fin-weight to Middle-weight. Single-elimination tournament was adopted in each weight division.

Out of the 12 HKUST Taekwondo team members, 7 males and 5 females, have participated in this competition. Two of them showed remarkable performance and won a medal in their own weight divisions.
